I wasn't just thankful to leave that terrible little room but I found myself actually thankful for the room itself... for having had to stay there. I had prepared myself for the long hard flight crossing... we were free to find by reminding myself of my commitment to remember the 'bigger picture,' that every detail of what we were doing, from start to finish, was part of a deeper question and commitment, that is: 'What are you willing to do, to be a part of God's plan to place His Word into the hands of those in China whom He had chosen before the foundation of the World? What are you willing to do... what are you willing to endure... what are you willing to put up with? Will you be willing and faithful to see His hand in everything and to thank and praise Him in everything... will you, like Paul, determine, 'I can do all things through Christ Who strengthens me.'?'

I will admit though, I might not have been so willing to seem so brilliant and 'right on' in my attitude if there hadn't been about 10,000 other hotels to choose from the next day. However, after praying for wisdom, it was the very first one we went to the next

morning that we eventually decided to move to after visiting several others during the day. (That first day was a Saturday, so we didn't have a another hotel and buy backpacks to use for carrying Bibles.) The hotel we chose even had a pool on the roof... now that was really cause for thanks after each day's hot, humid, sweaty trip into China! (Thankfully, the really nice hotel ended up being about the same price as the really awful one... most travelers simply don't have the opportunity to shop around after they arrive in Hong Kong, though; they've already been locked into a long term reservation by the time they get there.)

However... as bad as that wretched little room was... we do know that it was like a palace by comparison to how so many must live... what so many believers have to endure in so many parts of the world... we are just spoiled rich Americans... we see that... we have been blessed by God... it's difficult to always remember and remind ourselves of that fact.

God commands us to be grateful, to give thanks in everything. We all will be eternally grateful to Him for all He has done for us but we will also thank each other for the things we've done. Think about it... we will forever be real people with real personalities and real relationships. He is even now forming us into the people we will be. The only real difference between who we are now and who we will be then is the fact that we will be without sin and without any sin nature. We will know each other and even eventually meet everybody else who is in Heaven or on the newly recreated Earth.

For example... every time I visit my grandfather then... I will thank him for having been a Christian and leading my father or mother to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ and he will say, 'Well you know, Tom... the one you really ought to be thanking is John so and so, the old man who lived next door to us in Tennessee before I moved to Portland. When Debbie and I get there, there will be thousands of Chinese friends who will want to thank us for helping to get Bibles to them and we will, of course, like everyone else, deflect that thanks and give the glory to Jesus Christ, but we'll also want to see others thanked. We'll tell them the names of all the ones who we know had a part in our ministry on Earth, those who prayed and those who gave.

In Hong Kong and China we also handed out small Gospel booklets to carefully selected individuals. Two years ago we passed, in the subway, a crippled beggar who played a guitar everyday. This time, we handed him the Gospel along with a little money. Prayerfully, he'll come up to us in Heaven and say, 'Thank you, I'm here because of you.' And we'll say, the one you should really thank is Phoebe Lou... she's the one who supplied us with those tracts.'

Then there was the young couple who own the small fruit stand across the street from the hotel we stayed at in China last trip. We gave her a Bible this time. Hopefully, we'll see her in Heaven and she'll say, 'Thank you for not forgetting us, for coming back and bringing us a Bible.' And there is the big Israeli guv we met in the Hong Kong

customs line. We only spoke for a moment, but in parting I said, 'Read Ezekiel chapter 38... it's about to happen now!' Hopefully, we'll see that guy in the Kingdom and he'll say, thanks for that parting shot.'

While in Hong Kong we began to realize that the Bibles we were smuggling into China were even more unless we have family members who important, more valuable than we had ever before realized. God has plans for each one... none of them will return void, but each one will accomplish its intended purposes. Every Bible will be in the hands of someone or a family that God draws to Himself. Then, one day soon, at the Rapture, those same Bibles will be left behind in the empty houses and apartments from which God will have taken all those believers. That same day, millions more unsaved Chinese will pour into all those empty homes and they will all find those Bibles waiting for them.

The same is true of our homes now. Every one of us who know Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior will be taken at the Rapture, leaving behind everything we've collected in our lives here on Earth. Among all that meaningless stuff will be our Bibles. I'm thinking it would be a good idea

to have every Bible in the house put in places that will be clearly visible and, I think each one should have some kind of letter in it explaining why we disappeared, where we went and how that person could eventually come to the same place.
